Professional men's rugby union international club competition  
Involving Teams from Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Japan, Argentina  
Since 1996



##### International:

The All blacks are an international rugby team  
The best men's group in New Zealand

##### National:

Football team "All Whites"  
Founded in 1891



##### International:

Football was founded in 1891 under the name "New Zealand soccer"  
Name changed from "soccer" to "football" in 2007

### Typical food

#### Fish and Chips

Most popular meal for takeaway  
Came from Britain to New Zealand  
Eat while sitting on the beach  
In every town  
5 – 8 NZ\$



#### Hangi

From the Maori culture  
Includes vegetables and meat  
Slow cooked on a handmade underground oven  
Hot stones on the ground  
Cover with ground  
Left for 3-4 hours



#### Meat Pie

Part of New Zealand's identity  
Hand-sized meat pie – quick to grab  
With meat, onion, cheese or mushrooms inside  
5 – 8 NZ\$ per pie  
Founded in 1863



#### Roast lamb

Introduction by early European settlers  
A piece of meat for roasting  
New Zealand's favourite  
One of the country's most famous export meat



### Tradition

#### Ta Moko

Maori have a strong and long tradition of tattoos  
Men and women get tattoos  
On face, ass, thighs, and lips  
Head most sacred part of the body  
Often tell a story  
Family history, marriage
