1	<b>in</b> the upper left-hand corner
2	<b>at</b> the top
3	<b>in</b> the upper right-hand corner
4	<b>on</b> the left
5	<b>in</b> the middle / <b>in</b> the foreground / <b>in</b> the background
6	<b>on</b> the right
7	<b>in</b> the lower left-hand corner
8	<b>at</b> the bottom
9	<b>in</b> the lower right-hand corner

TIPS	
What?	This picture / photo shows ... Here, you can see ...
When?	This picture / photo was taken at (place) / in (year).

TENSE (ENGLISCHE ZEITFORM)	
Present Progressive	am / is / are + verb- <i>ing</i> (Peter is playing football).

**picture or photo?** **picture** = anything drawn by hand / **photo** = anything taken by camera
